Internet Search

Now you will do an Internet search! You and your partner will become more familiar with the Internet as you search to find requested information.

Write your answers to each numbered question on a separate sheet of paper.

- Start the web browser on your computer.
- Type the Web site address: [NOTE: The localization team needs to insert the
 address of an appropriate Web site that features specific information on the
 geography, culture, holidays, and so forth, of your country.]
- Make sure to check that the address you typed is correct since a typing mistake may take you to a different Web site or to a Web site that does not work.
- Press the Enter key, or click the Go button. Then, wait as the Web page loads on your computer.
- Read the Web page thoroughly.
 - 1. What are three pieces of information you have learned from this page?
- Click one of the hyperlinks.
 - 2. Where does the link take you?
- Go back to the first page by clicking the Back button on the toolbar.
- Click in the address bar, and type the following Web site address: [NOTE: The
 localization team must identify and insert a Web site and address that
 discusses the food of your country; India, for example, could use
 www.recipedelights.com/basics.htm as it translates into Hindi.]
- Find a new recipe you would like to try for one of your meals.
 - 3. What is the name of the recipe?
- Click in the address bar, and type the following Web site address: [NOTE: The
 localization team must identify and insert a Web site and address that
 reports on the sports of interest in your country.]
 - 4. What are two stories on the page about? Is there information on your favorite sports?

- Click in the address bar, and type the following Web site address: [NOTE: The localization team must identify and insert a Web site address that identifies what one's name means. Examples include: www.indiaexpress.com/specials/babynames, www.sanyal.com/india/babyname.html, or www.babynamenetwork.com/origin.cfm?origin=Chinese]
- Type your names or your family members' names.
 - 5. What do the names mean?
- You are going to visit a directory now. A directory will let you choose a big topic
 and then let you narrow your search by clicking topical hyperlinks. Click in the
 address bar, and type the following directory address: [NOTE: The localization
 team must identify and insert a directory address that is both kid-friendly
 and culturally appropriate. Some examples from the United States include:
 http://kids.yahoo.com and www.kidsclick.org]
- Click Science and Nature. [NOTE: The localization team should identify a comparable topic of interest to the students.]
 - 6. Where does the link take you?
- Click a topic of interest.
 - 7. What did you find when you went there?
- Click the icon on the toolbar that looks like a house.
 - 8. Where does the house icon take you?
- Exit your web browser.
