Comparison

- Notices unusual patterns in the world
- Looks at things from different points of view

Humor

- Notices things in the world such as riddles, jokes, and things out of place
- Makes others laugh by imitation
- Makes others laugh by pointing out funny things
- Makes others laugh by telling stories

Language

- Notices when language is especially effective
- Uses words to paint pictures
- Plays with language

Imagination

- Thinks of new uses for everyday things
- Imagines things in such detail that they seem real
- Includes unusual and surprising elements in projects
