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Story Collection Observation Template

Whether you use two columns, or otherwise separate your observations from your interpretations, it's essential that your notes are segregated into three records:

- The exact behaviors (including conversations) you are observing (described as accurately and objectively as possible). This column can be thought of as the evidence you are collecting.
- Your thoughts about what you are seeing and hearing. This column can be thought of as your initial hypotheses.
- Indicators as developed by program.

Sample Observation Notes Table

INDICATOR [from list]	OBSERVATIONS (behaviors, sequence and times of activities in the class, teacher-student interactions, quotes from teachers and students, etc.)	REFLECTIONS/Interpretation <i>(questions, conjectures about, and candidate interpretations of what you are seeing)</i>
