Did you know ...?

- Intel Labs employs 1,000 people across 10 sites worldwide.
- Over half of the Intel Labs team have a Ph.D.
- Intel has over 12 worldwide university research centers.
- 50 percent of Intel Labs researchers are focused on exploratory research versus directed research.
- There have been 12 Intel Labs-driven wireless and security standards adopted.
- Intel Labs members such as Mario Paniccia and Justin Rattner have won notable awards including EE Times' ACE Award for Innovator of the Year and R&D Magazine Scientists of the Year. Recently, Justin Rattner received an Ami de L'Europe-21st Century Industrial Innovation and Genevieve Bell received the 2013 Women of Vision Award Winner for Leadership from the Anita Borg Institute.
- Additional awards won by Intel Labs members include the German Award for Climate and Environment, and PC Magazine's Technical Excellence Award.

Intel Labs makes up only 1percent of the Intel population, but has:

- 18 percent of the Intel Fellows at the company.
- 22 percent of the academic papers published in the past 5 years.
- 36 percent of patents granted.
