

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2009, the Court entered an Order regarding Intel Corporation and Intel Kabuskiki Kaisha's Compliance with the Court's March 16, 2007 Order Regarding Intel's Evidence Preservation Issues ("Order") setting forth the deadline for Intel's compliance with the Order as April 1, 2009, and noting that Intel "reserves the right to request additional time if needed" and "AMD agrees to consider such request in good faith"; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2009, respective counsel for AMD and Intel agreed to extend the time for Intel's compliance with the Order from April 1, 2009 to April 15, 2009, as contemplated by the Order; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2009, respective counsel for AMD and Intel agreed to further extend the time for Intel's compliance with the Order from April 15, 2009 to April 17, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED BY AND AMONG AMD AND INTEL, THROUGH THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNSEL, AS FOLLOWS:

The date by which Intel must submit its Updated Disclosures (as defined in the Order) shall be extended to not later than the close of business, April 17, 2009.


