**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, simultaneously herewith the Special Master has issued an Order  
DM 35 on Advanced Micro Devices, Inc. and AMD International Sales & Service, LTD

("AMD") Motion to Compel Defendants Intel Corporation and Intel Kabushiki Kaisha ("Intel") regarding Rule 30(b)(6) and Document Requests ("Motion");

**WHEREAS**, the Special Master concludes that it is critically important to achieve final decision in this matter on an expedited basis;


**WHEREAS**, the Special Master believes that the time within which a party may, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 53(f)(2), file objections to – motion to adopt or modify – any Special Master's Order should be shortened;

**WHEREAS**, consistent with this approach the Special Master believes that any briefing to the Court on a Fed. R. Civ. P. 53(f)(2) application should be expedited, with a shortened page limit;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED THAT THE COURT:

1. Reduce the time permitted by Fed. R. Civ. P. 53(f)(2) from no later than 20 days from the date of the Order, to no later than 5 days from the date of the Order.
2. The initial brief in support of Fed. R. Civ. P. 53(f)(2) application should not exceed 5 pages single-spaced. Opposition letter briefs shall be served not later than 4 days following service of the application and shall not exceed 5 pages, single-spaced. Reply letter briefs shall be served not later than 3 days following service of the opposition brief and shall not exceed 3 pages single-spaced.
