
**ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
LENOVO GROUP LIMITED FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On April 15, 2010, non-party Lenovo Group Limited (“Lenovo”) submitted a second unopposed motion for extension of time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* received from Complaint Counsel on March 22, 2010 (“Subpoena”). Lenovo seeks an extension of time until April 25, 2010. Lenovo previously received an extension of time to move to limit or quash the Subpoena until April 15, 2010. *See* Order Granting Unopposed Motion of Non-Party Lenovo Group Limited for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, April 1, 2010.

Lenovo states that it is continuing its discussions with Complaint Counsel to resolve Lenovo’s concerns regarding the Subpoena and that, to facilitate those discussions and potentially avoid the necessity of filing a motion to limit or quash, Lenovo and Complaint Counsel have agreed that Lenovo may have a ten-day extension of time through April 25, 2010.

Based on the foregoing, Lenovo’s Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Lenovo shall have until April 25, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena received from Complaint Counsel on March 22, 2010.
