
**ORDER GRANTING FIFTH UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY  
HEWLETT-PACKARD COMPANY FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On May 5, 2010, non-party Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) submitted a Fifth Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Respondent Intel Corporation (“Intel”) on March 19, 2010.<sup>1</sup>

HP states that Intel does not oppose a fifth extension of time for HP to file a motion to limit or quash Intel’s subpoena, until May 10, 2010, so that the parties can try to reach agreement on the scope of the subpoena.

Based on the foregoing, HP’s Fifth Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that HP shall have until May 10, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served upon HP by Intel on March 19, 2010.
