**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY  
NVIDIA CORPORATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE MOTION TO  
QUASH OR LIMIT SUBPOENAS *AD TESTIFICANDUM***

On May 6, 2010, non-party NVIDIA Corporation (“NVIDIA”) submitted an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Motion to Quash or Limit Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* (“Motion”). NVIDIA requests an extension of the time to move to limit or quash 25 Subpoenas *Ad Testificandum* served on it by Respondent Intel Corporation (“Intel”) by mail on April 23, 2010 (“Subpoenas”). NVIDIA also requests that its obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoenas be tolled during the period of the extension.

NVIDIA states that it is in the process of negotiating with Intel regarding the Subpoenas and that the parties have agreed that NVIDIA may have an extension of time to move to limit or quash the Subpoenas through May 10, 2010, while the parties attempt to attempt to reach an agreement.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that NVIDIA shall have until May 10, 2010, to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoenas served upon NVIDIA by Intel on April 23, 2010, and that NVIDIA’s obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoenas shall be tolled during the period of the extension.
