
**ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
LENOVO GROUP LIMITED FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On May 10, 2010, non-party Lenovo Group Limited (“Lenovo”) submitted a Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* received from Respondent Intel Corporation (“Intel”) on April 20, 2010 (“Subpoena”). Pursuant to its unopposed motion submitted April 27, 2010, Lenovo previously received an extension of time through May 10, 2010. *See Order Granting Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum*, April 27, 2010

Lenovo states that it is still in the process of negotiating with Intel to resolve Lenovo’s concerns regarding the scope of the Subpoena. Lenovo further states that, to facilitate those negotiations, Intel has agreed that Lenovo may have an additional twenty-one days to submit a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena. Accordingly, Lenovo seeks an extension of time through May 31, 2010, and further requests that its obligations to otherwise respond to the Subpoena be tolled during the period of the extension.

Based on the foregoing, Lenovo’s Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Lenovo shall have until May 31, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena received from Intel on April 20, 2010, and that Lenovo’s obligations to otherwise respond to such subpoena shall be tolled during the period of the extension.
