**ORDER GRANTING THIRD UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
LENOVO GROUP LIMITED FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On May 28, 2010, non-party Lenovo Group Limited (“Lenovo”) submitted an unopposed motion for extension of time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* received from Respondent Intel Corporation (“Intel”) on April 20, 2010 (“Subpoena”). By Orders dated April 27, 2010 and May 11, 2010, Lenovo previously received extensions of time through May 31, 2010.

Lenovo states that it is continuing to negotiate with Intel to resolve Lenovo’s concerns regarding the scope of the Subpoena and that additional time is needed to complete those negotiations. Lenovo further states that Intel has agreed that Lenovo may have a seven day extension of time to submit a motion to quash or limit the Subpoena. Accordingly, Lenovo seeks an extension of time through June 7, 2010, and further requests that its obligations to otherwise respond to the Subpoena be tolled during the period of the extension.

Based on the foregoing, Lenovo’s Third Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Lenovo shall have until June 7, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena received from Intel on April 20, 2010, and that Lenovo’s obligations to otherwise respond to such subpoena shall be tolled during the period of the extension.
