SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Non-parties Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) and David Donatelli (“Mr. Donatelli”) file this second motion to extend the time permitted for HP and Mr. Donatelli to limit or quash the Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* Intel Corporation (“Intel”) issued to Mr. Donatelli.

HP accepted service of Intel’s Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* issued to Mr. Donatelli on Friday, May 28, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Intel’s Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* is June 7, 2010.

Intel does not oppose this second extension of time for HP and Mr. Donatelli to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* through June 11, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the Subpoena *Ad Testificandum* issued to Mr. Donatelli. 
