### **OPERATING SYSTEM OVERVIEW**

The Compaq Evo Thin Client T20 and Evo Thin Client T30 support the Windows CE .NET, Windows NT Embedded, and Windows XP Embedded operating systems. The purpose of this document is to compare and contrast the Windows CE .NET and Windows XP Embedded operating systems. The following table provides an overview of each operating system's core features.

Platform	Features
Windows CE .NET	The simple, low-cost Windows solution for replacement of traditional "green screen" terminals and the rapid deployment of Line of Business (LOB) applications to task-oriented workers.
Windows XP Embedded	The high-end Windows thin client solution that delivers no-compromise functionality including full Internet Explorer 6 browser, device driver availability, local Win32 application support and the highest levels of robust performance

### **OPERATING SYSTEM RECOMMENDATIONS**

The following table outlines certain platform recommendations for Compaq Evo Thin Clients based on various usage scenarios:
